Project Abstract: The purpose of this agreement is to obtain watershed management services on Fort McCoy in order to support military training and sustainment of the military mission. Services include completion of on-going watershed assessments, aquatic invasive control, and bio-monitoring studies to assess the aquatic habitat for 11 lakes and 71 miles of streams in two major watershed basins on Fort McCoy.
