Objective 1: Provide cultural resource program related information to the Government
CRM to complete actions related to the DoD Cultural Resources Award Report, Army
Environmental Database - Environmental Quality (AEDB-EQ), Integrated Natural
Resource Management Plan (INRMP), Installation Status Report (ISR), Environmental
Quality Report (EQR), Environmental Performance and Assessment Survey (EPAS), and
other databases and submissions that request the inclusion of cultural resources
related information as necessary to meet the objectives stated in AR 200-1.
