Project Abstract: The scope of this agreement is to provide professional and technical support for Fort Bragg's Cultural Resources Management Program: 1) the identification, evaluation, and protection of all sites, structures, and objects located on Army-controlled property that are eligible for or included in the National Register of Historic Places; 2) Curation of all artifacts, objects, records associated with cultural resources on Fort Bragg; 3) Coordination of consultation between Fort Bragg and American Indian Nations regarding cultural resources; 4) Public Outreach activities for Fort Bragg and the local communities.
