**Project Abstract:**

The goal of this cooperative project is to plan and hold a workshop that will bring together a network of practitioners from NPS, partners (including academics currently working on projects for the NPS Vanishing Treasures (VT) program), and on-the-ground park resource managers to exchange information and to develop consensus on guidelines to assess cultural resource vulnerabilities to temperature and precipitation extremes for cultural heritage in the southwestern US.
