#### **Project Abstract:**

The ultimate goal of the proposed research is to establish a critical understanding of and practical methods for restoring cheatgrass invaded sites in ROMO to native late-successional, perennial grass and shrub dominated communities. The roles and interactions of native seed mixes, AMF, and N levels in restoration will be investigated.
