Project Abstract: NPS GIS Program (GISP) and Colorado State University (CSU) will together to conduct and share in-depth research and to provide tactical implementation quidance for integration of volunteered geographic information (VGI) and web mapping services required by partner enterprise geographic information systems (EGIS) projects that lack the ability to manage and provide public access to their program information. Project partners include Denali National Park, the Harper's Ferry Center, Yellowstone National Park, National Trails, Planning, and Transportation programs interested in finding new tools and tactics for compiling, managing, and publishing enterprise data and maps that promote better understanding of natural, cultural, and anthropogenic resources.
