Project Abstract:

The University of Colorado will work with the National Park Service (1)to conduct an archival survey that will identify architectural drawings associated with the history of Yellowstone National Park and its concessionaires. These drawings may be located in various locations throughout the park including Xanterra (Park Concessionaire) buildings, maintenance offices, canyon storage attic and various closets, 2) prepare an archival survey report that describes the scope, content and location of architectural material throughout park to NPS standards, 3) if needed, transport the archival drawings to the Denver Service Center for microfilming. The University team will also be responsible for the return of the drawings to Yellowstone National Park, 4) re-house, re-folder, label and conduct preventative maintenance. Yellowstone's Heritage and Research Center will be the final storage location, 5) provide an overview of the work performed in writing and in person.

Outcomes with completion dates:

Consolidation, inventory and rehousing of over 15,000 of Yellowstone National Park's architectural drawings.
