**Project Abstract:**

This project is a joint effort between the National Park Service, Denver Service Center, Technical Information Center, and the University of Colorado-Boulder to assist parks within the NPS Intermountain Region in terms of processing and cataloging park archives according to NPS museum standards. Currently, several parks within the NPS Intermountain Region have a backlog of unprocessed and uncataloged archives, and degradation of original materials will continue until basic preservation, such as processing and rehousing, is completed. This project will involve processing and cataloging archives collections at Glacier National Park, with assistance from the park curator, Deidre Shaw. It also will result in the preparation of archival survey reports that describes the scope, content and location of the collections, to be prepared according to NPS standards.

**Outcomes with Completion Dates:**

Process, rehouse and catalog archives at Glacier NP. As noted below, the park projects and final requirements - including a detailed scope of work as well as due dates for each of these individual efforts - will be negotiated between the NPS and the University of Colorado-Boulder.

The first task in this project will be for the National Park Service (DSC-TIC) and the University of Colorado-Boulder to work with Glacier NP to develop a detailed scope of work, budget and final product dates.
