Project Abstract: This project will allow the University of Colorado at Denver to work with Grand Canyon National Park to develop an on-line interpretation module that discusses the geology of the Grand Canyon. This project will expand the partnership that was initiated in 2005. UC-D faculty, staff, and/or students will work with NPS staff to provide computer and educational expertise for the Grand Canyon National Park Geology Views module currently "in preparation." This work can include one of several critical areas in Views module development, including 1) module design and asset collection, 2) graphic design and assembly, and 3) development of supporting educational materials. As in all Views modules, work on the Grand Canyon module will focus on the local resources and issues but will also contain basic geological concepts that will be applicable to many other parks in the NPS System with geological features.
