Project Abstract: Sand Creek Massacre National Historic Site (SAND) is located in Kiowa County, Colorado within the Central Shortgrass Prairie Ecosystem. SAND was authorized in 2000 with an authorized area of 12,500 acres. The current established boundary of SAND encompasses approximately 2,400 acres. The National Park Service and SAND previously contracted and compiled research to evaluate the status of the natural resources and associated ecological habitat at SAND. The existing research results are extensive, varied, and may contain conflicting data. The objective of the current project as proposed here, is to evaluate, reconcile, and report on the varied findings of the resulting research as compiled - for the purpose of determining consistencies, inconsistencies, and overall completeness - in order to ensure effective long term planning and subsequent sound management actions. The cooperator from the University of Colorado at Boulder will:

- Document the status of current natural resources reports for completeness with regard to information necessary to determine and manage site conditions.
- Identify consistencies and inconsistencies in existing data and reports.
- Identify potential data gaps and making recommendations for additional data collection, if necessary.
- Produce a draft and final report detailing these findings.

Additional funds were added at the end of the FY to allow for both the scientific review and development of more web content by a research associate currently working with Utah State University.

Outcomes with Completion Dates

- August 2007 to June 2008 literature review and compilation of existing information, synthesis of existing information, and initiation of report writing.
- June 1, 2008 report writing, completion of first draft of report, draft review by NPS.
- December, 31, 2008 report revision and submission of final report.
