Project Abstract: The Crown of the Continent Research Learning Center in Glacier National Park will cooperate with Montana State University to mentor a student to develop two-sided pamphlets to inform park seasonal staff about current research topics that inform management decisions. The Research Learning Center will provide office space and housing for the duration of the project and will provide a list of pertinent research topics as well as some background information. The student will be expected to research the topics using the park library, the internet, and the materials provided and will provide draft copies for review. The NPS and MSU will jointly participate in reviewing the documents.
Outcomes with completion dates: A series (4 – 8) of two-sided pamphlets describing up-to-date research on current topics that can inform management decisions and are of interest to the public (due December 31, 2004).
