## Project Abstract:

The westslope cutthroat trout (WCT) is imperiled and listing under the Endangered Species Act (ESA) is imminent unless immediate action is taken. The goal of this project is to establish self-sustaining, genetically-pure WCT population within Yellowstone National Park (YNP) in an effort to restore and prevent the ESA listing of this unique native subspecies. WCT are an important resource in Yellowstone because they are a fundamental component of a relatively intact, naturally-functioning ecosystem that includes the ESA-listed grizzly bear and many other important and sensitive species. The proposed project will allow YNP biologists to partner with multiple government agencies as well as expert NGOs to renovate one watershed in Yellowstone's Northwest corner through removal of nonnative fish species and reintroduction of genetically-pure WCT. These activities are critical to ensuring the persistence of this unique aquatic resource and the ecosystem that depends on it. Cooperators at MSU will work with NPS to conduct logistical planning including compiling equipment needs, budgeting, and producing technical documents that will guide on-the-ground restoration activities during the summer of 2008.
