<b>Project Abstract:</b> University and agency researchers from the Rocky Mountains Cooperative Ecosystem Studies Unit (RM-CESU) and NPS technical contacts will develop a list of participants and workshop agenda. RM-CESU will take the lead in contacting workshop participants, addressing logistical aspects of meeting preparation and implementation, and preparing a written record summarizing the meeting that will include specifications for the ideal products. The University will procure a trained facilitator and recorders to participate in the workshop and produce a record of the discussions. The NPS-Biological Resource Management Division will provide a meeting location, lodging for participants, funding for non-federal employees and workshop expenses. Cooperating entities may provide support for personnel to participate in the workshop.
