Project Abstract: Dr. Barton and NASS Director Solomon Little Owl plan to bring members of UNC's Native American student population to RMNP for 1-2 days in Fall 2011 and visit various park sites. This visit will then be followed by a focus group with NASS students in order to discuss the obstacles and challenges to park visitation facing millennial-aged NASS students at UNC. A graduate student at NASS will be employed to help assist with the creation of digital materials, and resulting videos and text will be made available via the UNC website and linked to RMNP where possible. Dr. Barton will interact with park staff to ensure products meet NPS standards and The goal of the project is to gauge Native American student perspectives quidelines. and experiences of RMNP in order to increase this population's visitation and participation in citizen science programs between UNC-RMNP. The project comes on the heels of Colorado PBS's initiating a video documentary project with NASS Director Solomon Little Owl beginning in June 2011. Dr. Barton and Solomon Little Owl intend to feature the UNC Native American student visit to RMNP as a portion of the PBS documentary. ROMO staff will also work closely with the UNC Center for Engaged Research & Civic Action to explore possible overlaps in existing materials and opportunities for joint development on related projects.
