They will consolidate that information into an Archeological Overview and Assessment Report recommended under DO-28 (Archeology).

The Guidelines for DO-28 for an Archeological Overview and Assessment shall be followed. This document

- describes the area's environment and culture history;
- lists, describes, and evaluates its known archeological resources;
- describes the potential for as-yet-unidentified archeological resources;
- describes and evaluates past research in the area or region;
- outlines relevant research topics; and
- provides recommendations for future research.

The Archeological O&A also lists the location of collections of archeological materials and associated records related to park resources; and contains a comprehensive bibliography."

The final form of the report will be a result of direct discussions between the park staff and the PI, but will contain, at a minimum, one chapter each about

- 1. the current environment;
- 2. the regional cultural history;
- 3. the past archeological work in the park;
- the relationship of the park resources in the regional context;
- 5. identification of deficiencies and remedies;
- 6. direction for future research; curation status; and
- 7. a comprehensive bibliography of the park's archeological resources related documents.
