Project Abstract:

The University of Wyoming will assist Curecanti National Recreation Area with 1) a review of study design, 2) a review of data and data collection methodology, 3) recommendations on statistical methods to be used for sampling, and 4) analysis of existing data in relation to an ongoing study intended to develop habitat models for critical life stages of the Gunnison Sage Grouse (Centrocercus minimus). Habitat models are expected to provide valuable information that will allow managers to evaluate the condition of current available habitat, evaluate habitat needs and deficiencies, and develop habitat management prescriptions that can be applied to public and private lands throughout the Gunnison Basin to enhance Gunnison Sage-Grouse population sustainability.

Outcomes with completion dates:

The key product will be a final written report of findings from the data review and evaluation, recommendations of any additional data needs, and a design for developing a habitat utilization model. One or more on-site visits to consult with Park personnel and/or to present and discuss the findings will also be arranged.
