Project Abstract: The University of Wyoming and NPS, Devils Tower NM will work together on a project to survey Devils Tower National Monument (DETO) for the location, extent, habitat, and numbers of rare plant species recognized as state plant species of concern (SPSOCs) by the Wyoming Natural Diversity Database. This will include the following tasks:

- Inventory and record likely habitat and SPSOC locations.
- Assess plant locations for unnatural threats that are/may be impacting SPSOCs present and recommend conservation measures for locations to minimize disturbance to SPSOC
- Assemble the resulting information into a final report, including an update to the existing
 occurrence records for all SPSOCs within DETO (report appendix), and incorporated in
 statewide status information for each SPSOC documented that will be prepared as a state
 species abstract for use as a field guide and abbreviated status report by National Park
 Service personnel and other Wyoming data users (report appendix).

Any additional vascular plant species not previously known from the flora of Devils Tower National Monument that is identified in the course of rare plant survey will be documented. This is not a monitoring study but will assist in reviewing monitoring needs and priorities.
