Project Abstract:

The University of Wyoming American Studies Program (UW-AMST) will work cooperatively with Grand Teton National Park on the completion of a National Register of Historic Places determination of eligibility (DOE) for the Helene Whittmore property, the Hartgrave/Halpin property, and the Rudd property in Grand Teton National Park (GTNP). UW-AMST will (1) conduct research on the history of the Whittmore, Hartgrave/Halpin, and Rudd properties at the University of Wyoming, American Heritage Center and in Jackson Hole. Research may include interviews with family members or other people affiliated with the properties, (2) analyze the history and significance of the properties in the context of the larger history of settlement in Grand Teton National Park and the Jackson Hole area, (3) complete a Wyoming Cultural Properties Form for each property. Number three on the form will be the main focus for this project. The descriptions should include buildings, structures, and landscape features and (4) photograph the sites and the interior and exterior of each building and structure. Significant landscape features should also be photographed. Each photo will be labeled according to National Register standards.
