## **Project Summary:**

**The Wyoming Conservation Corps crew and one/two NPS workers concentrated on reproducing the historic fence-lines and corrals at the historic Mason-Lovell Ranch site. One-hundred rail ties were planted and the associated rails attached. Crews also worked to clean up deadfall and branches.**

**Lessons Learned from this project. The project went extremely well with the WCC crew. Historic fence posts were located and the new corrals and fences were created in close approximation to the original location.**
