Glacier National Park worked with a number of cooperators, including University of Calgary to organize a conference at Waterton Lakes NP in fall 2007 to highlight the 75<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the Waterton-Glacier International Peace Park. The conference focused on sharing the experiences of managers responsible for resources and visitors in other parts of the world. Conference sponsors include: Glacier National Park, Waterton Lakes National Park, Rotary Clubs in Montana and Alberta, and the Universities of Montana, Calgary and Lethbridge.
