Project Abstract: The goal of this research is to scope and conduct research activities that are aimed at informing riparian restoration efforts at three sites in the western U.S.: 1) the Bill Williams River, Arizona; 2) the Colorado River delta in the U.S. and Mexico; and 3) Frijoles and Capulin Creeks in northern New Mexico (Bandelier National Monument).
