

NEW FORESTRY FIELD COURSE: FALL 2016

FOR 391-02 Special Topics: Timber Sale Preparation (1 credit)

This is a new, one-credit elective for upper level forestry majors providing hands on experience preparing timber sales at the Lubrecht Experimental Forest under an adaptive silviculture regime.

We will spend ½ days (Mondays: noon-5:30pm) in the field preparing timber sales. Activities will include: timber marking, unit layout, road layout and timber cruising. Through the course students will actualize real-world forestry skills to increase their knowledge of technical forestry and applied silviculture.
